III. Eligibility

- Applicants must (be expected to) have successfully completed a Bachelor's degree from either in or outside of Korea or equivalent to the above approved by a related academic policy.
- The applicant and both parents must hold a non-Korean nationality.

- Applicants must have a language proficiency exceeding at least one of the following requirements: TOEFL 530(CBT 197, iBT 71), IELTS 5.5, CEFR B2, TEPS 600(NEW TEPS 326)
- The above requirement may be waived for applicants with a nationality of an official English speaking country who submits a college/university academic transcript and graduation certification from the country.

- 2). Academic transcripts and graduation certifications must be in English.
- 3). Any documents in languages other than English, must be translated and notarized within 3 months.
- 4). If all application materials are not submitted within the deadline, 2020. 7. 30. (Thu) 16:00, the applicant will be disqualified.
- 5). Once the application is submitted, cancellation or modification will be restricted.
